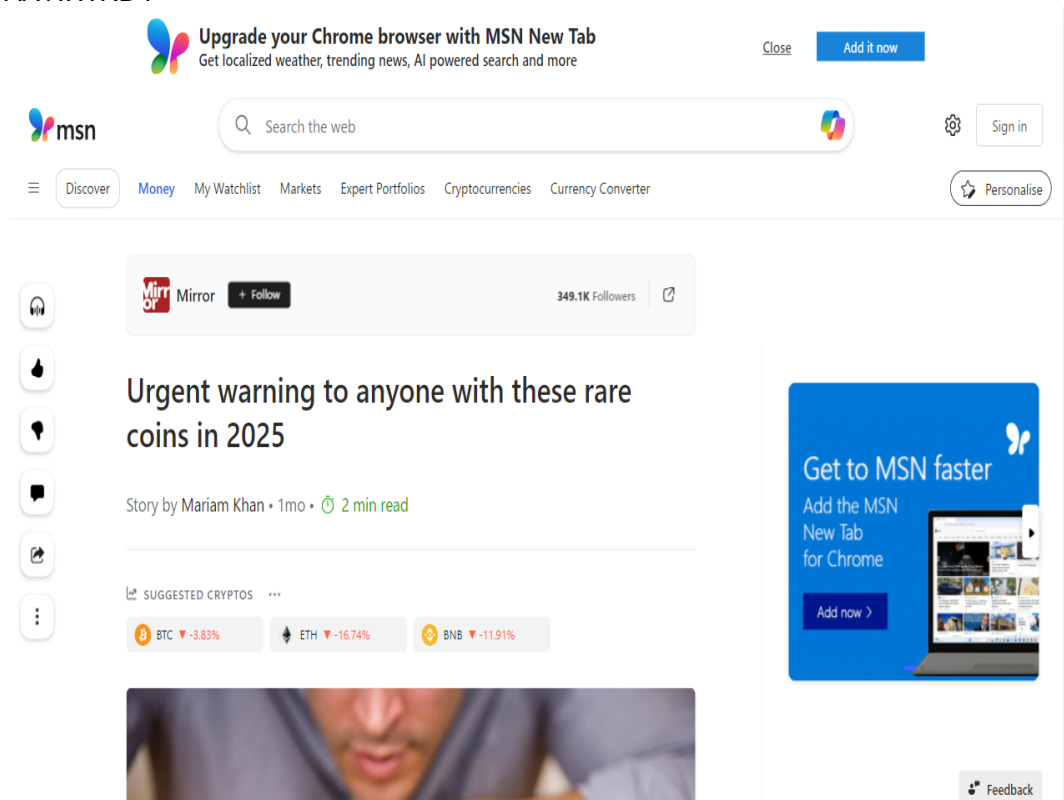

If you've ever come across a handful of old coins tucked away in a drawer, now's the time to take a second look.

While most coins are only worth their face value, certain rare coins could be worth a small fortune. Knowing which ones to hold onto can make all the difference, especially if you're unaware of their true value. If you suspect you have a rare coin, it's worth getting it appraised by a professional. But do some research first to avoid unnecessary costs. A quick online search can help you determine whether your coin is a hidden treasure, Yahoo reports.

1913 liberty head nickel The 1913 Liberty Head Nickel is one of the rarest and most coveted coins in the world. With only five known to exist, these nickels have fetched millions at auction, including one that sold for \$5 million in 2007. If you happen to have one, it could be worth far more than just five cents.

1794 flowing hair dollar Minted between 1794 and 1795, the Flowing Hair Dollar is a true piece of American history. Only around 150-200 of these coins remain, and their value can soar into the millions. One such coin was sold for \$6.6 million, though less pristine versions can still fetch thousands. A well-preserved Flowing Hair Dollar could easily be worth a small fortune.

1940s mercury dime The 1940s Mercury Dime is another coin to watch for. Although they aren't as rare as others, these dimes can still bring in significant value, especially if in good condition. Minted between 1916 and 1945, they feature a winged Liberty on the obverse and an olive branch on the reverse. A well-preserved 1940s Mercury Dime sold for as much as \$8,519 at auction.

Saint-gaudens double eagle The Saint-Gaudens Double Eagle was originally worth \$20 when minted between 1907 and 1933. Today, it's one of the most iconic gold coins, with high-grade examples fetching hundreds of thousands. The 1907 edition can reach values up to \$300,000, depending on its condition. This coin is a stunning example of American coin design and a prized addition to any collection.

1909-s indian head penny With just over 300,000 ever minted, the 1909-S Indian Head Penny is another highly sought-after coin. Known for its intricate design, this penny can be worth thousands, especially if in good condition. One example sold for \$3,400 in 2021. If you have one of these rare pennies, it's worth taking a closer look.
